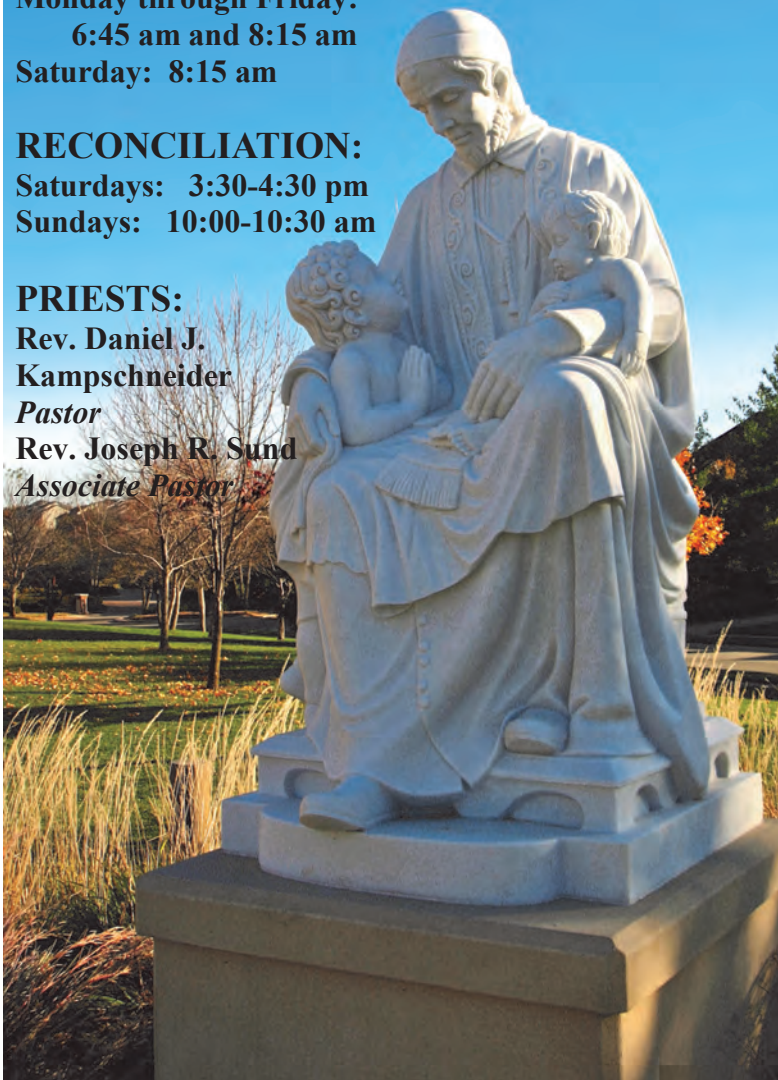

A MESSAGE FROM BOB VERKUILEN

In July 2009, I joined the St. Vincent de Paul staff as the Director of Development. Like so many people, my impression of a Director of Development was to raise money. Well, I am here to tell you, that is just one piece of the puzzle.



Over the last eight years, together, we have achieved some amazing financial accomplishments. Our parish debt has been reduced from just over \$3.6 million in July 2009 to less than \$550,000 today. The Junior High Wing, two conference rooms, some office space renovations and the multi-purpose sports field were constructed without taking on any additional debt. We have worked hard to increase our Sacrificial Giving, and as a result, we finished the 2016-17 fiscal year over \$140,000 ahead of budget. Lastly, we kicked -off the 25th Anniversary Parish Center Capital Campaign earlier this year. To date, we have raised over \$4.6 million in pledges from over 700 donors, and have collected over \$2.2 million.

Every gift made to St. Vincent de Paul helps us carry out our mission of helping others to know Jesus better through worship, faith formation and service. It is the generosity and support from everyone that has allowed our parish to remain financially stable.

This financial success has been wonderful, but it truly is just one part of my job. Honestly, some of my most memorable experiences during my time here have come from people giving of their Time and Talent. Obviously, the financial gifts are extremely important to help our parish function, but it is the giving of ourselves in faith that is equally important.

Without sharing too many details, one example that continues to come to mind involves a family in which one of the parents was diagnosed with cancer. The immediate pouring out of support for this family was overwhelming. There were meals prepared and gift cards purchased. There were hours “donated” to watch the children while the parents went to appointments or just spent time together to “work through things.” Donations were made to help create awareness for the disease. Gifts came in from “friends” and “strangers” alike. It was a wonderful example of Stewardship; people stepping forward to share their Time, Talent and Treasure. This is just one of the many examples that go on in our parish regularly.

Please do not hesitate to contact me to discuss how you can share your gifts with the parish as a whole, or perhaps help that specific family or individual. I guarantee that your efforts will be greatly appreciated, and I am just as certain that you will get as much, if not more, out of the experience.
