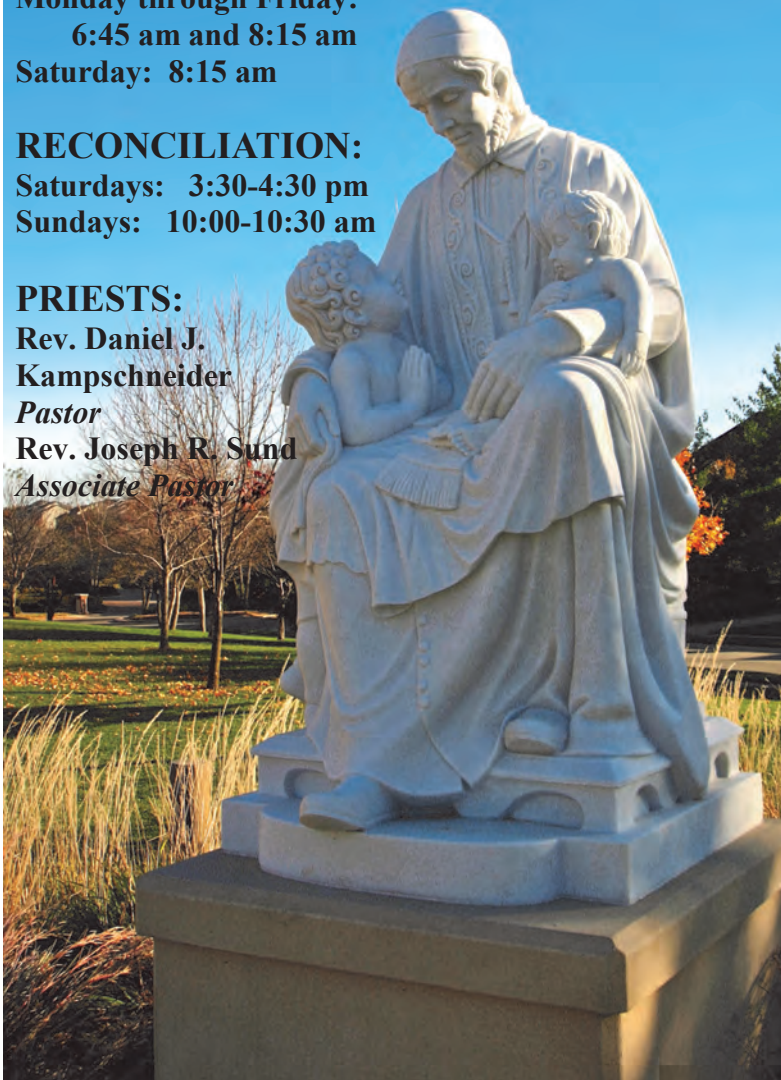

A MESSAGE FROM JENNI VANKAT

Come, Holy Spirit! Those are the words I use often throughout my days as a Pastoral Minister and Adult Formation Director. I continually pray for the Spirit's guidance with the interactions I have and the choices and decisions that I make here. It is humbling to walk with parishioners going through illnesses, loss, and struggle or just even trying to manage the details of everyday life. One recent experience still sits on my heart.



Since beginning my time at St. Vincent, I frequently visited a parishioner whose abilities became gradually limited by a disease, to the point of being unable to move any limbs. In the early days of our time together, we were able to have conversations about family, parish happenings, the weather and such. Each visit included sharing prayer and Eucharist. I heard the frustration of not being able to care for one's self. I heard the covenantal love one has for a spouse. I heard the desires for health, safety, and happiness a parent has for their children. And then I couldn't hear. The vocal muscles were failing in the end. Interactions were by eye contact and gentle touch until the last breathe was taken. I wasn't there for that moment, but I had so many other moments too sacred for words but felt deeply in my heart.

I share this story because I grew closer to God through this experience, through this part of my "job." What a gift the parishioner gave to me – to journey alongside through it all - the smiles and suffering. I became more gentle, more trusting of God's will, more aware that worth is not about abilities. I felt the rich soil there is when God calls people together to share in his life, suffering, death and glory. The witness of faith by this parishioner was such rich soil. I sprouted in it.

"But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold." Matthew 13:23

Thank you to this parishioner and all who allow staff members into your lives! May the seeds you sow in my life, and hopefully the ones I sow in yours, bear great fruit!

OUR PARISH HAS A RELIC OF THE TRUE CROSS available for private prayer beginning Monday, July 17 through Sunday July 23 in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.
